What is Succession Planting?



- Multiple Planting Timelines
- Planting vegetables of the same type at different times - using multiple time lines.

Why Plant Multiple Timelines?



- Maintains a steady harvest of each vegetable.
- Maximizes use of garden space
- Controls pests and disease
- You can grow fall, winter and storage crops
- Vegetables grow better at different times of the season.

Principles of Succession Planting



- When should you plant multiple Timelines?
 - 1) Fast growing vegetables.
 - 2) Vegetables that ripen quickly.
 - 3) Vegetables that are prone to insects and disease.
 - 4) Heat Sensitive Crops.
 - 5) Vegetables you alot.
